**RING ONE – START 10am PROMPT**

Judge; Mrs C Pratt

**Classes 1 – 10; IN-HAND      START 10am PROMPT**

**Class 1 – BEST TURNED OUT** Horses/Ponies any age/height. To be judged on cleanliness of horse/pony, tack and handler's turnout. Conformation will not be taken into account. Rosettes to all competitors and a small prize to the highest-placed competitor who has turned out their own horse/pony without an adult's help

**Class 2 – CHILD HANDLER under 10 YEARS** Handler to have attained their 4<sup>th</sup> birthday. Horse/pony any age/height. To be judged on child's ability to handle horse/pony in the ring

**Class 3 – CHILD HANDLER 10 – 15 YEARS** Horse/pony any age/height. To be judged on child's ability to handle horse/pony in the ring

**Class 4 – BEST CONDITION 100% GRASS KEPT** Horse/Pony any age/height. **MUST LIVE OUT ALL YEAR ROUND.** To be judged on the overall body condition including the feet

**Class 5 – BEST CONDITION STABLED or PART STABLED** Horse/Pony any age/height. To be judged on the overall body condition including the feet

**Class 6 – BEST COLOURED** Piebald, Skewbald, Spots, Palomino, Cremello, Appaloosa, Roan or Dun. Horse/Pony any age/height

**Class 7 – BEST BAY, GREY, CHESTNUT, BLACK or BROWN** Horse/Pony any age/height

**Class 8 – PRETTIEST MARE or FILLY** Horse/Pony any age/height/breed/type

**Class 9 – MOST HANDSOME GELDING** Horse/Pony any age/height/breed/type

**Class 10 – MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND** Small or Large breeds. Must be registered. Any age

**Class 11 – UNREGISTERED HORSE or PONY** Any age/breed/height/type. Not to be registered with any breed society. Any age

**Class 12 – FANCY DRESS** *\*\* Not to commence before 1pm \*\**

In hand or Mounted. (If mounted, a hard hat to current approved safety standards **MUST** be worn). Rosettes to all competitors and gift vouchers to top six competitors

**Classes 13-21; RIDDEN not to commence before 1.30pm**

Judge; Miss J Hobbs

**Class 13 – LEAD REIN PONY** Not to exceed 128cm. Rider not to have attained their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in current year. Snaffle bridle with lead rein attached to noseband

**Class 14 – FIRST RIDDEN** Not to exceed 138cm. Rider not to have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in current year. Snaffle bridle only. Cantering in individual show only. See rule 13

**Class 15 – MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND** Small & Large breeds. Must be registered

**Class 16 – RIDING HORSE/PONY** Horse/Pony any height. Class may be split according to horse/pony height if sufficient entries. See rule 13

**Class 17 – NOVICE SHOWING** Rider not to have won 1<sup>st</sup> place in any showing class. Horse/pony any height. Snaffle bridles only to be worn

**Class 18 – COLOURED HORSE/PONY** Piebald, Skewbald, Spots, Palomino, Cremello, Appaloosa, Roan or Dun. Horse/Pony any height

**Class 19 – BEST BAY, GREY, CHESTNUT, BLACK or BROWN** Horse/Pony any height

**Class 20 – UNREGISTERED HORSE or PONY** Any breed/height/type. Not to be registered with any breed society

**Class 21 – RIDING CLUB or PONY CLUB HORSE or PONY** Any height or type. To be judged on suitability for all Riding Club or Pony Club activities. Will be judged on performance and way of going. Riders will be expected to include a small jump in their individual show

## RING TWO

Judge; Mrs C Edwards

Class 22 – HANDY HORSE/PONY

On lead-rein. Competitors must be aged under 10 years

Class 23 – HANDY HORSE/PONY

Off lead-rein. Competitors any age

Horse/Pony any height. These classes will involve negotiating a short course of every-day obstacles, with each obstacle to be marked out of 10. In the event of a tie, the fastest time will win

Classes 22 & 23 will run concurrently from 11am until 12noon and again from 1pm until 2pm

## RING THREE – SHOW JUMPING – START 10am PROMPT

10am – 12noon CLEAR ROUND JUMPING

Entries on the field. £3 per round. No entries will be accepted after 11.30am

Class 24 – MINIMUS FUN JUMPING To commence at approx. 12 noon

Jumps will be approx. 1ft 6in. This class is aimed at absolute beginners & lead rein competitors who have no competitive experience. All competitors who jump clear in the first round will then jump a second round against the clock. So as not to exclude competitors from future Novice classes, no placings will be awarded, but all double clears will receive special rosettes and the fastest double clear will receive a prize

Class 25 – BEGINNERS NOVICE Jumps not to exceed 1ft 9in. Open to horse/pony & rider not to have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> in any show jumping class. Competitors under 10 years of age may be led

Class 26 – PAIRS RELAY Jumps approx. 2ft. First rider to jump course and then pass whip to second rider, who will then jump their course. Lead rein competitors are permitted. Fastest pair clear will win. Entries for this class will be £8 per pair with NO LATE ENTRY FEE CHARGED ON THE DAY

Class 27 – HORSE & HOUND RELAY Jumps approx. 2ft. Horse & rider to jump first. Rider to dismount & negotiate course with dog. A handler will be required for horse/dog changeover. Fastest clear rounds to win

Class 28 – NOVICE Jumps approx. 2ft – 2ft 3in. Open to combination of horse/pony & rider not to have won any show jumping class

Class 29 – 2ft 3in OPEN Open to any horse/pony & rider combination

Class 30 – 2ft 6in OPEN Open to any horse/pony & rider combination

Class 31 – CHASE-ME-CHARLIE Entries will be accepted on the day for this class at no extra charge.

# **SHOW RULES**

1. All persons riding on the showground must be wearing a hard hat to current approved safety standards. Failure to do so will result in a £10 fine
2. Any complaints must be in writing with a £10 deposit, within 30 minutes of the alleged incident. The deposit will be refunded if the complaint is upheld
3. The Judges decision is final **AT ALL TIMES**
4. **ALL DOGS TO BE KEPT ON A LEAD**
5. All horses/ponies must be ready to enter the ring when called. **COMPETITORS ENTERING CLASSES WHICH MAY CLASH DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK.** No entry fees will be refunded
6. No unauthorised persons are allowed in the show ring
7. Collecting ring stewards can refuse late arrivals if judging has started
8. Horses/ponies may be measured in the case of a dispute
9. All Mountain & Moorland ponies must be registered in the Stud Book of their respective breed and must be shown in accordance with their breed standard. Breed Society numbers must be stated on the entry form
10. All ridden horses/ponies must be aged 4 years or over on the day of the Show
11. **NO COLTS OR STALLIONS ARE ALLOWED AT THIS CHILDREN'S SHOW**
12. All riders must have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year
13. No lead rein exhibits in classes 14 or 16
14. Long sleeves must be worn in all jumping classes. Long hair must be tied back and worn securely off the collar – no long pony-tails please!
15. We recommend that correctly fitting protectors are worn for all show jumping classes. Protectors may be worn over jackets if required
