ALL LATE ENTRIES: £10.00 (cash only for late entries on the day)

at the judge's discretion. No phone entries please

**All trophies awarded will be subject to a cash deposit of £10 per trophy, up to a maximum of £20

In each class, the highest placed horse/pony aged 1, 2 or 3 years and the highest placed horse/pony aged 4 years & old will qualify for their respective age-group Championship, to be held following the completion of ALL classes

Special rosettes will be given to highest placed 1, 2 or 3 year old in all classes
(excluding classes 5 & 15)

For ease of identification, WHITE ARMBANDS are to be worn by all youngstock handlers

◆ ◆ Each ring will incorporate a lunch break between classes ◆ ◆

RING 1 – to commence at 9.30am

Class 1: BEST TURNED OUT – Horse or Pony any age/type/height. To be judged on cleanliness of both horse/pony and handler

Class 2: BEST CONDITION HORSE or PONY – Any age/type/height. Must be either fully or part stabled. Not to enter class 12

Class 3: NOVICE HORSE or PONY – Any age/type/height. Must NOT have been placed 1st in any showing class prior to 2017

◆ ◆ FIVE-MINUTE BREAK ◆ ◆

Class 4: COLOURED HORSE or PONY – Piebald & Skewbald only. Any age. Will be judged 50% on colour and 50% on conformation & type. Horses/ponies entered in class 4 cannot enter class 14

Class 5: YOUNGSTOCK – Any breed/type/height. To be born after 1st Jan 2014

Class 6: BEST SOLID COLOUR HORSE or PONY – Any age. To include Black, Brown, Bay, Grey, Cremello, Chestnut and any other solid colour. White markings on face and legs are permitted

AFTERNOON CLASSES WILL NOT START BEFORE 12.30pm

Class 7: COMPETITION HORSE or PONY and POTENTIAL COMPETITION HORSE or PONY – Any age/height

Class 8: PRETTIEST MARE – Any age/type/height

Class 9: MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LARGE BREEDS – Any age. Must be registered – to include New Forest, Welsh C & D, Fell, Dales, Highland and Connemara

Class 10: RIDING HORSE or PONY – Any age

Class 11: SHETLANDS – must be registered. Any age

JUDGES

Classes 1 – 6: Mr M Saunders

Classes 17 – 22: Ms C Pratt

RING 2 – to commence at 10.00am

Class 12: GRASS KEPT HORSE or PONY – Any age/type/height. Must live out all year (please be honest!). Not to enter class 2

Class 13: NON-SHOW TYPE HORSE or PONY – Any age/type/height. To include non-registered M&Ms. Horse/pony must NOT be registered with any breed society

◆ ◆ FIVE-MINUTE BREAK ◆ ◆

Class 14: COLOURED HORSE or PONY – to include Palomino, Dun, Roan and Spotted. Any age. Will be judged 50% on colour and 50% on conformation & type. Horses/ponies entered in class 14 cannot enter class 4

Class 15: VETERAN HORSE or PONY – Must be aged 16 years or over. Any type/height. Age of the horse/pony to be displayed on the handler's left arm. Special rosette to the oldest entry. "Patience of Jobe" sash to the highest WDRC member or member's child. If sufficient entries, the class may be split on age (16 – 21 years and 22 years & over)

Class 16: POTENTIAL LEAD-REIN & LEAD-REIN PONY – Must not exceed 128cm (12.2hh) at maturity. Any age/breed/type

◆ ◆ LUNCH BREAK ◆ ◆

AFTERNOON CLASSES WILL NOT START BEFORE 12.30pm

Class 17: HORSE or PONY SUITABLE FOR DRIVING – Any age/height/type. May be shown in-hand, on long-reins or in harness

Class 18: MOST HANDSOME GELDING – Any age/type/height

Class 19: MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND SMALL BREEDS – Any age. Must be registered – to include Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor and Welsh A & B

Class 20: COB – Any age/breed/type/height. To include Show Cobs and Traditional Cobs (traditional cobs to be shown with full mane, tail and feathers)

◆ ◆ FIVE-MINUTE BREAK ◆ ◆

Class 21: HUNTER & HUNTER PONY – Any age

Class 22: CHILD HANDLER – Child to be aged 4 – 15 years. Mares and geldings only – NO colts or stallions. To be judged on the child's ability to handle their horse/pony correctly and safely in the ring. Riding Hat and suitable footwear must be worn. If sufficient entries, class may be split on age of handler. Special rosette to youngest handler

SHOW RULES

1. Rings to start promptly at scheduled times. All competitors to be at the collecting area at the ring when the final call for the class is announced – any late competitors will NOT be allowed into the ring once the class has begun.
2. It is in the interest of all competitors to note that entering classes which may clash do so at their own risk. Permission to transfer between rings during judging is purely at the discretion of the Judge and cannot be guaranteed, so please choose your classes carefully as NO refunds will be given for missed classes.
3. A surcharge of £3.00 per competitor will be made to alter classes on the day of the show. In the event of the show being cancelled, an administration charge of £3.00 per competitor will be retained. NO refund of entry fees can be given unless a vet certificate is shown.
4. All late entries on the day will need to be made using a new entry form – NO late entries to be added to a pre-entered form. Entry forms will need to be filled out with full details, name & address of competitor including a contact phone number and/or email address and to include details of horse/pony where applicable and SIGNED – incomplete forms will not be accepted.
5. Any complaints must be made in writing with a £10 deposit within 30 minutes of the alleged incident. The deposit will be refunded if the complaint is upheld
6. The judge's decision is final AT ALL TIMES
7. ALL DOGS TO BE KEPT ON A LEAD PLEASE. OWNERS MUST PROVIDE BAGS AND CLEAR UP ANY MESS LEFT BY THEIR DOG!
8. In the event of low numbers of entries, the Committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate classes and withhold rosettes as appropriate
9. In the event of large numbers of entries, the Committee reserve the right to divide classes and award additional rosettes as appropriate
10. NO unauthorised persons are allowed in the show ring
11. Any Entire horse or pony over 2 years old MUST have the appropriate licence available for inspection at the show
12. All Mountain & Moorland ponies must be registered in the NPS Stud Book or in the Stud Book of their respective breed and must be shown in accordance with their breed standard. Breed Society numbers must be stated on the entry form
13. All Arabs, Anglo-Arabs & Part-bred Arabs must be registered in the appropriate register
14. All trophies are to be signed for before leaving the showground and must be returned by 1st April 2018
15. WDRS MEMBERS PLEASE NOTE: If you forget your membership/competitor number, you will still be able to enter on the day but you will have to pay the late entry fee of £10 per class.
If you have pre-entered, you will have to pay an extra £4 for each class entered as a non-member/late entry and will not qualify for the member's rosette. Anyone found using another member's number to enter will be asked to leave the showground and further action may be taken.
